## **GOVERNOR'S EXECUTIVE ORDERS**

**State of Emergency:** On January 7th, the Governor continued the Proclamation of Disaster Emergency through February 6, 2022 at 11:59 p.m., unless sooner terminated or extended in writing.

Per Section Five of this order, non-lowa licensed doctors and medical staff are temporarily allowed to practice in lowa as long as they are licensed to practice in another state.

## **Legislation:**

**Liability Immunity:** On June 18, 2020 the Governor signed Senate File 2338, which grants liability immunity to health care providers. In part, the Bill states, "a health care provider shall not be liable for civil damages for causing or contributing, directly or indirectly, to the death or injury of an individual as a result of the health care provider's acts or omissions while providing or arranging health care in support of the state's response to COVID-19." Liability does not apply when the acts are reckless or willful misconduct. This Bill is retroactive to January 1, 2020.
